While they significantly enhance efficiency and standardization in audit workflows, it is important to clarify that these services do not constitute the use of a specialist under AU-C Section 620: Using the Work of an Auditor's Specialist.

Understanding the Context

AU-C 620 applies when an auditor uses the work of a specialist, defined as an individual with expertise in a field other than accounting or auditing to assist in evaluating financial statements. This typically involves areas such as valuation, actuarial science, or IT systems.

AuditMiner provides SOC report analysis as a supplementary service. Our subject matter experts review the SOC reports, then compile standardized toolkits with structured insights such as summaries, flagged exceptions, and guidance on performing walk-throughs of complementary user entity controls (CUECs). However, AuditMiner does not issue opinions on control design or effectiveness within the context of a specific engagement.

AuditMiner is not considered a specialist for the following reasons:

- 1. No engagement-specific judgments: While AuditMiner provides expert analysis of SOC reports, the service does not interpret how that information applies to the audit engagement's specific risk assessment or control evaluation.
